PEAK SEASON ORGANIC CHERRIES









GOOD NEWS! Organic Dark Sweet Cherries are in their peak for Week 29! Flavor and quality are excellent. Promote during mid-July since the season will wind down fast. Washington growers are expecting to be finished shipping by the end of the month.

NOTE: Organic Rainier Cherries are done for the season.

NOTE: There is a heat wave in the Central Valley of California which is slowing **Organic Peaches**, **Plums**, and **Nectarines** yields, and temperatures are too high to be able to pick very long each morning. Stay tuned for more updates on the long-term effects, if any.

California growers are winding down on **Organic Apricots.** A very small crop out of Washington is expected to for the rest of July.

Organic Eastern Peaches have called it a season due to the heat in South Carolina. Thank you to all who supported this program this year.

Organic Verry Cherry Plums will be in season through late July.



OG MELONS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons are promotable out of South Carolina. This will be new crop and fruit is looking excellent. California supplies are also available, and fruit is eating very well.

Organic Mini Seeded Watermelons are also in season. There is renewed consumer interest in seeded varietals.

Organic Seedless Watermelon Bins will be available again out of California. Quality should be excellent on this new crop. Sizing is larger, so expect more 45ct availability.

Organic Black Sweet Gem Watermelon bins will be available for mid-July as well.

Organic Cantaloupes and **Honeydew** out of California have outstanding quality. Prices will drop once supply strengthens towards the end of July.



OG TOMATOES

LOCAL Organic Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes from Lady Moon Farms are available with great quality and will continue to roll in from Pennsylvania throughout July.

LOCAL Organic Heirloom Tomatoes will be starting to arrive from Lady Moon Farms in Pennsylvania by 7/16. We will also have some from Green Field Farms out of Ohio.

LOCAL Organic Roma Tomatoes have started in small way from King Family Farm out of Lancaster County, PA. Volume will increase into the middle of July.

Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes have been increasing in pricing primarily due to low volume on larger sizing and Canada finishing their crop for the season. As Canada finishes up this month, we will be pulling in LOCAL Organic Vine Ripe Round Tomatoes from Pennsylvania and Ohio.

NOTE: With all the heat in the mid-Atlantic recently, local **Organic Tomato** growers expect a flush of crown pick in mid-July, followed by shortages in mid-August due to heat-related bloom drops.

NOTE: Our Quebec greenhouse **Organic Tomato** grower, Savoura, will go into a time of low to no production on **Organic Cluster** and **Beefsteak Tomatoes**, along with some of their specialty items while they reset the greenhouses will new plantings for ramping back up in late summer and early fall.



OG BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Blueberries will start to become promotable out of the Pacific Northwest. Volume should ramp up quickly and pricing will be pretty promotable. Quality looks nice out of Oregon and Washington to start.

Organic Blackberries continue to be available out of California. Pricing is flat, quality has been nice, and flavor is excellent. **LOCAL** New Jersey crops will be finished after the extreme heat has affected quality.

Organic Raspberry pricing is easing off slightly as supplies get better. Quality has been very nice, and fruit is eating excellent out of CA.

Organic Strawberries continue to be available out of California with no change in pricing as markets remain flat and volume is steady. Quality has been nice, with some bruising due to heat.





OG ONIONS

LOCAL Organic Red Onions are starting from King Family Farms out of Lancaster County, PA. We will see a massive decrease in price once we cut over to these new crop PA **Reds**. Size profile is going to be heavy to jumbos, and mediums will not be that prevalent.

NOTE: Organic White Onions are going into a little gap period in late July out of California. Then, there will be none to load until about the first week of August.



OG MANGOS

Organic Round Mangos are in good supply for the middle of July!

Expect the **Organic Ataulfo Honey** variety to become more limited as the month progresses.

Organic Specialty Mangos are available and now is your time to promote! Organic Nam Doc, Mallika, and Green Thai varieties will all be available in limited supply.



OG AVOCADOS

ALERT! Organic Hass Avocado supplies remain very tight as more limited volume following a stoppage of import supply from Mexico have prices sky rocketing.

California and Peruvian fruit have dwindled with increased demand. 60ct fruit from Mexico is extremely tight as fruit is sizing bigger for the rest of the month of July.



OG DRAGON FRUIT

Back in stock! Organic Yellow Pitahaya Dragon Fruit will be available in limited supplies from Ecuador for the middle of July.



OG WARM VEG

Organic Cucumbers and Eggplant will be all LO-CAL moving forward from Flaim Farms out of New Jersey and Lady Moon Farms out of Pennsylvania. Product has been arriving with great quality!



OG GREEN BEANS

LOCAL Organic Green Beans out of Pennsylvania will be back in stock for mid-July! They will be starting with gradual volumes but hoping to be fully stocked in the coming weeks.



OG SWEET POTATOES

Organic Purple Stokes Sweet Potatoes are starting to wind down for the season. Going forward, they will be switching from #1 size to Mediums for the remainder of the season until we get into new crop in September. At this point, don't expect any gaps in supply.



OG CARROTS

We have a good supply of both **Organic Orange Bunch**and **Rainbow Bunch Carrots**, coming from a
mix of **LOCAL** and California farms.



OG LETTUCES

All **Organic Leaf Lettuces** have ramped up from Quebec, and the quality is nice. The weather has been absolutely ideal, so it's time to promote **Organic Eastern Green Leaf, Red Leaf**, and **Romaine Lettuces**.





OG ASPARAGUS

Organic Asparagus volume is increasing out of Mexico and pricing is easing off. Quality has looked sharp.



OG GRAPES

California **Organic Grapes** have started in a slow way with some Mexican fruit still in the pipeline. Expect better market pricing towards the end of July.

Organic Cotton Candy Grapes continue from Mexico for the month of July.



OG PINEAPPLES

ALERT! Organic Pineapples will be extremely limited for the rest of July. Expect prorates and out of stocks in supply! Pricing is also much higher.



OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli from Braga Fresh will be in outstanding supply for the next couple weeks. Not only is it organic, but it's grown regeneratively!

Organic Broccoli supplies are improving, but demand has been very good, so pricing should hold steady. We've also started to source Quebec grown **Organic Broccoli** for the season.

Organic Cauliflower will be in good supply heading into August. We'll have plenty of availability on 12 ct wrapped, and the quality has been great providing a good time to promote.

OTHER STORIES

- NOTE: California Organic Lemon quality and supply is average. We will transition mainly into Argentina fruit for the time being to cover the gap on quality and keep costs lower.
- All varieties of Organic Hard Squash have transitioned from Mexico to new crop California in the
 Creekside label. Product is looking beautiful. Pricing will be steady to the increased pricing of the
 new crop. Organic Kabocha Squash will gap on
 supply for a couple weeks.
- Organic Green and SunGold Kiwifruit are in excellent supply for the month of July.
- New crop **Organic Ginger** from Peru will be steady for July.

- ALERT! Organic Royal Star Papayas remain limited. Prorates and out of stocks are expected for the month of July.
- NOTE: Organic Brussels Sprouts will be in a gap until August. Growing conditions have not been ideal, and all growers are in the same short-lived gap.
- GOOD NEWS! Organic Celery will be very promotable through the remainder of July. We'll have all options including naked, sleeved, and hearts.
- Organic Gold and Red Beets are well-stocked with a mix of LOCAL and California sources.
- Import Organic Pears continue with limited supplies. Expect new crop California Organic Bartlett
 Pears to begin towards the middle of August followed by Bosc towards late August.





Cedar Meadow Farms is operated by the Steve Groff and his family in Lancaster County, PA. He pioneered the "Permanent Cover Cropping System" to enhance soil and water quality, along with reducing pesticides. Fresh produce is grown on 200 acres of land that was purchased by his grandparents in 1935 – a legacy that the 4th generation is beginning to manage.


Very simply, cover crops are specific crops that they plant in the off-season on the very same fields where they grow our cash-crops (gourds, pumpkins, tomatoes...) These cover crops provide a "cover" during the winter and spring seasons to protect their fields. The living roots that dig into the soil year-round infuse it with nutrients, replacing what was removed during harvest.

The roots also create healthy soil that's resistant to run-off during rain, protecting the surrounding water shed and providing immensely better water far down-steam. This is all done in place of traditional tilling, which simply turns the soil over with no added or long-term benefit. No-till farming is much more work, but the long-term benefit is enormous. After 30+ years of cover-cropping, the fields planted help grow better, more nutrient-rich plants.

CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

LOCAL TOMATO OUTLOOK





Cedar Meadow Farms located in Lancaster County, PA is run by Steve Groff who is a pioneer in the agricultural space and particularly in regenerative farming. This year from Cedar Meadow Farms we are carrying their LOCAL 15lb Heirloom Tomatoes as well as a mixed Heirloom 8/1 quart open top. Quality is outstanding. This crop is field grown under high tunnels, which means we can get LOCAL Heirlooms sooner, and as long as whether plays nice, we can have them later in the season.

There are some concerns to mention as far as availability. We can expect a flush of LOCAL Heirloom Tomatoes between the middle and end of July. All of this high heat has really caused some serious bloom drop on these heirlooms as well as other varieties locally. With that being said we can expect a shortage of tomatoes by mid-August.

LOCAL Vine Ripe Round Tomatoes from Fifer Orchards out of Delaware arrived with outstanding quality and will continue throughout July! High tunnel grown and volume will increase.

Beefsteak Tomatoes have been increasing in pricing primarily due to low volume of larger sizing available. Quality remains outstanding out of Canada.

NOTE: With all the heat in the mid-Atlantic recently, local **Tomato** growers expect a flush of crown pick in mid-July, followed by shortages in mid-August due to heat-related bloom drops.



CV MELONS

GOOD NEWS! Seedless Watermelons continue to be very promotable out of the Carolinas as Georgia starts to finish up. Quality has been excellent. This high heat could push the LOCAL Delaware and Pennsylvania crops to come on early this season. Growers are expecting fruit in both states by the end of July.

Large **Seeded Watermelons** are selling very well this year, and some **Yellow Flesh Watermelons** will be available week to week during the summer.

Mini Seedless Watermelons continue to be available out of North Carolina, and California is starting to flush as well. Pricing is promotable and quality is excellent, and fruit is very sweet like candy.

Cantaloupes are peaking on 9ct with 12ct being less available. Quality out of California has been outstanding!

Specialty Melon offerings for mid-July include: Tuscan Cantaloupes, Heirloom Cantaloupes, Athena Cantaloupes, Golden Dew, Golden Hami, Honey Kiss, Summer Kiss, and Sugar Kiss.



CV STONE FRUIT

HEAT NOTE: It's a tough week in California for **Stone Fruit** with the temperatures over 100 degrees. Daytime highs are expected to remain there for at least mid-July. Fruit is not releasing from the trees and stunting the fruits' growth. It will be a day to day harvest update. Stay tuned for updates on any lingering impacts.

GOOD NEWS! Yellow Peaches are an exception with excellent supplies from California as well as LOCAL New Jersey and Pennsylvania. It's time to promote! We have some LOCAL New Jersey White Peaches that just joined the mix.

California Pluots/Plumcots, including Black, Red, Mottled, and Plumogranates, are all in season from California.

Black and **Red Plums** are in excellent supply. California **Yellow Midas Plums** are also in season.

California Verry Cherry Plums will continue through Week 29 or 30.



CV CHERRIES & APRICOTS

GOOD NEWS! The heat out West has brought on some Cherries for mid-July promotion. There are some short-term deals to be had on all sizes of Dark Sweet Cherries.

Cherry supplies are expected to significantly drop in late July, and prices are expected to go up until mid-August when the crop should finish completely.

Rainer Cherries are limited and expected to finish completely by the end of July.

Skylar Rae Cherries (yellowish undertone with a deep red blush) are a great eating experience — put this high-end variety into your set while you can in mid-July!

Apricots are winding down for the season.

Crimson Rose Apriums are now available. **Apriums** are expected to go into August.





CV LETTUCES

GOOD NEWS! Eastern Lettuces from Quebec will be in full swing for the remainder of July.

Now is the time to promote as pricing will remain promotable on **Green Leaf**, **Red Leaf**, **Romaine Lettuce**, **Romaine Hearts**, and **Iceberg Lettuces**. Quality this season has been very solid.



CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

GOOD NEWS! Cauliflower is in good supply from Salinas, CA. We now have nice supplies of Eastern Cauliflower from New York and Maine on cello wrap. Quality has been very nice.

Broccoli Crown supplies are improving very quickly from the West Coast and growers on the East Coast are also ramping up in supplies. Quality has been excellent across the board, and pricing will become more promotable as we head into August.



CV PEPPERS

NOTE: Yellow, Orange, and Red Bell Peppers out of Mexico continue to cross in a small way but may have quality issues due to the extreme heat.

Another thing affecting this is California has had 10+ days straight of temperatures above 110 degrees, and one day was 120 with no rain.

NOTE: This has completely stopped Red Pepper production and there are no La-Rouge/Elongated Red Peppers for at minimum the rest of July. This will start to change the Pepper market into the middle of July.



CV PINEAPPLES

ALERT! Pineapple supplies will be extremely limited for the middle of July. This is expected to last through the rest of the summer. Pricing has increased considerably.

Specialty varieties like Del Monte's **PinkGlow** will also be out of stock.



CV SPECIALTY

Yellow Pitahaya and White Flesh Dragon Fruit will be in good supply for the middle of July. This marks a return to the marketplace for Yellow Pitahaya after a brief gap. Pricing should be promotable.

Rambutan in a 6/12oz clamshell will be steady for the middle of July!



CV GRAPES

Mexican **Grapes** are finished on basically everything except the **Cotton Candy** variety. California is delayed due to extreme heat.

Expect good supply on jumbo fruit from Coachella, CA and average supply of XL/LG fruit out of the Central Valley for Week 29 due to heat.



CV SQUASH

LOCAL Green and Yellow Squash have been arriving from Hess Farms out of Pennsylvania as well as out of New Jersey with outstanding quality. This will remain steady into the end of July. This is one item that is very promotable.



CV ASPARAGUS

Asparagus supplies remain light coming out of Peru and Mexico. Pricing remains strong. Quality has been excellent. Jumbo/XL sizes are extremely limited, so expect gaps and very high pricing.



CV SWEET CORN

GOOD NEWS! Sweet Corn is available from LOCAL states – Pennsylvania, Delaware, and New Jersey. All are harvesting and quality has been very nice. Bins and cases are available.





CV CUKES, BEANS, & PEPPERS

NOTE: Super Select Cucumbers, Green Beans, and Green Peppers prices will remain strong with bloom drop affecting yields and high heat affecting quality. We are rolling with all LOCAL product out of NJ and PA.



CV EGGPLANT

LOCAL Eggplant prices will remain promotable as of right now. Product is rolling in from New Jersey and will start in PA by the middle of July.



CV KIWIFRUIT

Green and **SunGold Kiwifruit** varieties from New Zealand remain strong in supply for the month of July.



CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Strawberries are promotable as heat brought on a harvest flush in CA and growers had to move fruit quickly. Expect pricing to remain fairly affordable but start to rise again in the following weeks. Fruit is on the smaller size but has been eating very well.

Blackberry pricing will get stronger as supplies slow down. CA is the only region with volume right now. Quality has been excellent and eating very well.

GOOD NEWS! Blueberries will become very promotable as the Pacific Northwest deal ramps up quickly. Fruit from Washington/Oregon and British Columbia is starting to come on with good volume. Quality looks excellent to start. New Jersey will be finished after the extreme heat.

NOTE: Raspberries continue to be limited coming out of California. Quality has looked nice but needs to move through quickly due to high heat in the growing regions. Pricing will remain strong as well.



CV ONIONS

LOCAL PA Simply Sweet Onions will get started in a limited way. Production will build up through the week of 7/28 and then are expected to be in full production.

Pricing at this point is expected to be higher than what we have been seeing on **Vidalia Sweet On-ions**, but that could change in the next couple of weeks. In the meantime, **Vidalias** are rolling along with good supply and nice late season quality.



CV AVOCADOS & MANGOS

NOTE: Hass Avocados have begun to rebound after a tough end of June and beginning of July. Supplies from Mexico have begun to flow again, and supplies are increasing stateside. Overall fruit is sizing a little bigger in the size curve making 60 size fruit and smaller more difficult to source. Peru and Chile also have limited fruit in the marketplace. Expect pricing from Mexico to be somewhat volatile as the month progresses. Pricing is down slightly for the middle of July since the pipeline is being refilled.

Mangos have seen some challenges related to weather recently. Rain halted harvesting last week and Hurricane Beryl provided some shipping challenges making some scramble for fruit. Most fruit is sizing bigger, making 12ct Red Round Mango varieties tighter than previous weeks.

Ataulfo/Honey Mangos have also been limited and Mexico prices are higher.

OTHER STORIES

- We will cover the gap on **Oranges** with California **Valenica Oranges** and Imported **Navel Oranges** when we can procure them.
- Import **Mandarins** quality is outstanding from all regions. California is done for the season.
- Celery quality has been very nice, and volumes on naked, sleeve, and hearts are expected to remain steady for the last few weeks of July.
- NOTE: The market on Plantains, both green and ripe, has become a little more limited from the tropics. Plantains are expected to be tight through the fall on supply.
