# ORGANIC APPLES PRIMED FOR PROMOTION









GOOD NEWS! Organic Apples are primed for promotion this winter. We're seeing amazing quality, good selection, and affordable pricing since growers had such good volumes come off the trees in Washington this year.

Organic Envy Apples are plentiful out of Washington! This apple is a combination of the best-selling Gala and the Braeburn varieties that was developed in New Zealand that is now taking over the US with amazing flavor and slow-to-brown flesh.

Organic SugarBee and Rockit Apples are particularly good varieties to promote as there is a display contest at Four Seasons for December.

New crop Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples are now plentiful in full 40lb tray pack boxes.

Varieties in great supply from the Pacific Northwest: Organic Ambrosia Fuji, Gala, Granny Smith, Honeycrisp, Lady Alice, Pink Lady, Rockit, SugarBee, and SweeTango Apples.

NOTE: Organic Opal Apples are one of the only apples that are limited right now due in put to high pack outs of small fruit and lower grades.



#### OG BERRIES

Organic Blueberries continue to be available out of Peru. Pricing has dropped off to more manageable levels as import supplies have increased. Quality has been outstanding.

NOTE: Organic Blackberries continue to be available from Mexico and limited harvests from California. Quality has been spotty this out of Mexico due to weather challenges limiting shippable supplies. USA quality has been nice but much more limited in supply. Pricing remains on the higher side.

Organic Strawberries remain available out of Baja, Mexico, and Florida is also starting with light volume. Quality has been nice, and pricing continues to be mixed. With more availability expected from Baja and Florida, expect prices to ease to off a bit to keep fruit moving.

NOTE: Organic Raspberries will be extremely limited with high pricing out of Mexico. Pests have damaged fields, limiting production. Quality has been nice overall on what is available. Expect possible limits and shortages.

#### OG CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Navel Oranges are in stock with the early Fukumoto/Beck varieties. Quality out of California has been great.

**GOOD NEWS! Organic Clementine and Satsuma** Mandarins are in peak supply. Bag and bulk options are available.

Organic Lemons from California continue to show great quality as prices are slowly coming down.

Organic Cara Cara Navel Oranges will arrive to the East Coast the week before Christmas.





#### **OG WARM VEG**

GOOD NEWS! Lady Moon Farms' Organic Green Peppers, Eggplant, and Zucchini continue to grow in Punta Gorda, Florida. There will be promotional chances all month long.

Mexican production is also robust. Organic Yellow Squash, Zucchini, and Cucumbers are in plentiful supply and easily accessible.



# **OG PEPPERS**

**ALERT! Organic Color Bell Peppers** are extremely tight. Canada is finished with their crop and Mexico does not start to ramp up until about the second week of December.

Right now, Israel is the only growing region of Organic Color Bell Peppers around, and their logistics for exporting are constrained due to the conflict. This market is expected to improve by the holiday slightly. Mexico is expected to start in mid-December.



# **OG SPROUTS**

#### **BRAND UPDATE:**

After decades of business, Sproutman has closed and sold their operation to Jonathan Sprouts.

Moving forward, Jonathan Sprouts brand **Organic Sprouts** will be offered by Four Seasons Produce with a similar assortment to Sproutman.

Due to the abrupt nature of this change, there may be some short-term supply hiccups as they get up and running with Jonathan's.



# OG BROCCOLI

**GOOD NEWS!** East Coast **Organic Broccoli** is still widely available in December. Californian output in the southern growing region has started to rise. During the holiday season, there will be a robust supply volume and competitive price.



### **OG PEAS**

**Organic Snap** and **Snow Peas** will come back into season around Christmas. Weather challenges, causing the plants to be slow to mature, have really pushed off the loading date. These will be arriving in a 10lb option.



#### **OG SPECIALTY**

**NEW! Organic Eggfruit/Canistel** will be available from Florida for a limited time.

Organic Kiwano Melons, Passion Fruit, and Feijoa will all be available in limited supplies from California for the month of December.



# **OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS**

Californian **Organic Brussels Sprouts** stabilized their supply level in the first part of December. Even though supplies are becoming more readily available, production costs have remained high in December due to a lack of overall market availability. Anticipate continuing circumstances of this kind during the holiday season.



# **OG GRAPES**

**NOTE: Organic Grapes** from California have finished for the season.

Import Organic Green Grapes are in limited supply on the East Coast, and import Organic Red Grapes will be available in limited supply starting around December 14.



#### **OG ASPARAGUS**

**ALERT! Organic Asparagus** has become limited, and there is very little volume coming out of Mexico. Sourcing will be from a variety of suppliers in an attempt to stay in stock. Expect higher pricing.





**OG CELERY** 

NOTE: Californian Organic Celery is getting increasingly pricey in December. Although availability and quality have not changed, promotional chances should not be anticipated.



**OG POMEGRANATES** 

**Organic Pomegranates** from California are in stock, and will be steady for early December. Quality this year has been good.



#### OG TOMATOES

**Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes** from Savoura are sizing small, so we are looking at some other shippers in the short term to fill with larger product.



# **OG LETTUCE**

GOOD NEWS! There is an abundance of Organic Leaf and Romaine Lettuce coming from the East and West Coast! While Organic Red Leaf Lettuce has started a bit slowly, Lady Moon Farms in Florida has started with high volumes on Organic Green Leaf and Romaine Lettuce. Look forward to a productive rest of the month!

Production from California has shifted southward to the growing regions of Yuma, AZ and El Centro, CA, and both output and quality are strong! Furthermore, sustained supplies of **Organic Iceberg Lettuce** and **Romaine Hearts** are coming from the southern West Coast regions. Volumes and pricing should remain stable throughout December.



# **OG CAULIFLOWER**

Early December saw a shortage of **Organic Cauliflower** from the Yuma, AZ and El Centro, California farming regions, which increased prices. The market will start to weaken as the holidays draw near, and more supply from these expanding regions becomes available. Anticipations for the holidays need to be reasonable prices and consistent availability—nothing extreme.



# **OG TROPICALS**

**Organic Pineapples** supplies have been steady, and volumes have been good as we start the month of December.

**Organic Green Skin Avocados** from Florida are winding down and will be done for the season by mid-December.

**Organic Papayas** from Mexico will be steady. Quality has been good.

**ALERT! Organic Mangos** will be out of stock in the middle of December. Ecuador fruit is severely delayed, and crop supplies are way down from a year ago.

# **OTHER STORIES**

- Organic Asian and Bartlett Pears will be wrapping up for the season towards the end of December. All other pear varieties will remain promotable.
- Organic Kiwifruit is available from California and European imports. Pricing has dropped slightly due to an uptick in supply volumes from Italy and Greece.

25lb **Organic Green Beans** will be available from Florida. We will primarily be carrying the 15lb row pack box from Covilli Organics which is set to arrive early December. We are expecting to have steady volume into and through Christmas.

10/11b **Organic French Beans** bags are available. Christmas volume is booked and will be available, assuming no major weather challenges.

Take a good look at your inventory on Glacé/Candied Fruit and holiday shipper displays around December 12th-15th to make sure that you have it all out on the sales floor. Consider reducing the retail so you don't carry it over past the holiday. Turn your cash over and start out fresh next year.

# 2. PARTY TRAYS & GIFT BASKETS

These are a MUST during the holidays for those hosting parties or going to gatherings! Veg and fruit trays sell very well during December. Plan out your orders with your Four Seasons rep.















Many independent retailers find success in packing their own custom fruit and gift baskets in store. Gone are the days of Red Delicious Apples, Globe Grapes, and Florida Navel Oranges navels. Include modern varieties like premium California Navel Oranges and Washington Fuji, Granny Smith, and Honeycrisp Apples. Premade fruit baskets may be available by pre-order from Four Seasons as well. Merchandise gift boxes of Ooranges and Mandarins too.

### 3. EASY-PEEL MANDARINS

# 11. ORDER & DISPLAY PLANNING TIPS

- Key Christmas produce displays should be in place by December 16th to maximize sales and profits and to keep your labor force as efficient as possible.
- Bring in your tonnage and items on your December 15th-19th deliveries.
- Stay ahead on your "hard goods" like potatoes, onions and dips. Your shrink risk is minimal, but if you are out of product and waiting for deliveries you are going to miss sales and disappoint customers.
- Keep bananas with good yellow color on display these are great in fruit salads! Stay ahead with color.
- · Beginning on the Wednesday prior to Christmas, every day will be busy and you'll want to capture as many sales as you can.

# 12. SMART LABOR PLANNING

- Develop an off-hour or evening fill schedule for your "hard goods", like nuts, dried fruit, potatoes, and onions, and "longer code date value-added" items, like salad dressings & dips, salsa, guacamole, hummus, and croutons, juices and jarred fruits, fruit mixes, and snacks.
- · Daytime labor should be focused on fruit, vegetable, salad displays and engaging your customers.
- Large orders are expected for delivery on 12/22 and 12/23. Plan ahead so you won't be waiting on delivery trucks those days with items that could have been brought in earlier.

# **DECEMBER BERRY OUTLOOK**









**Blueberries** continue to be available out of Peru. Quality has been nice, and prices continue to come down slightly to move fruit. Pricing and availability should be steady ahead of the holidays.

**Sweetest Batch Blueberries** are available from Driscoll's, along with **Jumbo Blueberries** from other shippers.

**Blackberry** prices will begin rising again as volumes slow back down. Quality has been nice overall but supplies will tighten up.

**Strawberries** are coming in out of Florida. We have switched all orders to Florida fields, and quality has looked outstanding. Volume is steady but will start to increase as prices will start to come down a bit to help keep fruit moving.

**NOTE:** Raspberry supplies are extremely tight and limited. There is a pest issue limiting shippable fruit. Quality overall has been very nice, but expect high prices through the end of the month with possible pro-rates.

Driscoll's **Rainbow Pack Berries** (Blackberries, Blueberries, and Raspberries) are now available.



# CV FALL FRUIT & SPECIALTY

POM Wonderful **Pomegranates** and **Pomegranate Arils** continue in peak season through Christmas.

**Black Mission Figs** will be steady from Mexico in 12/8oz clamshells for the beginning of December. The California season has ended for the East Coast.

**Fuyu Persimmons** will be in good supply for December. **Hachiya Persimmons** are starting to wind down for their peak season.

10lb **Lychee** fruit is going to be available during December.

**Stem & Leaf Satsuma Mandarins** are in-stock from California.

**Navel Oranges** from California are showing top-notch quality with strong supply in all sizes and grades. **Cara Cara Oranges** will be in stock starting 12/12, and **Vintage Sweets Heirloom Navel Oranges** starting 12/16.

**Star Ruby Grapefruit** and **Sunburst Tangerines** from Florida are in peak season.

**California Lemons** supply continues to get stronger. Expect prices to slowly drop as we enter mid-December. **Limes** remain promotable from Columbia and Mexico.



# CV LETTUCE

GOOD NEWS! The Lettuce category had transitioned smoothly to the El Centro, CA/Yuma, AZ desert growing region.

**Leaf Lettuce** supply is strong, driving costs down to an advantageous point while offering stellar quality.

**Romaine Lettuce** transitioned smoothly, but the supply volume is still more standard than promotable.

**Iceberg Lettuce** quality and supply volume have been strong, driving promotable prices in December.

And while **Romaine Hearts** follow suit with **Romaine**, product is still available, but by no means promotable approaching the holiday season.





# **CV APPLES & PEARS**

GOOD NEWS! Eastern and Western Apples are in great supply. Most prices are staying the same or slightly coming down.

Washington **Pears** are in good supply. Most prices are staying the same or coming down slightly.



# **CV BEANS**

**NOTE**: 25lb **Green Beans** are available. Prices and demand are on the rise due to weather challenges in Florida, as we head into Christmas.

10/11b French Beans are available, and Christmas volume is booked and will be in supply, assuming no major weather challenges.

GOOD NEWS! California Jumbo Artichokes are enjoying significantly better conditions as mid-December draws near. Substantial reductions in costs combined with higher volumes create the ideal environment for marketing opportunities.

GOOD NEWS! In December, Brussels Sprouts maintain their stellar production and economical costs. During this time of robust output, California growers' quality remains exceptional.



#### CV KIWIFRUIT

**Green Kiwifruit** is in better supply. Fruit from Italy and Greece are beginning to be steady on the East Coast, causing pricing to drop slightly.

Zespri is now up and running with their **SunGold Kiwifruit** crop out of Southern Europe.



# **CV CELERY**

California **Celery** is still widely accessible in December. Since Thanksgiving, the quality has been excellent, and pricing has stayed reasonable.



# **CV PEPPERS**

**NOTE: Color Bell Peppers** remain tight until Mexico starts with more volume. This market is expected to be expensive through Christmas.



# CV ASPARAGUS

NOTE: Asparagus has become tight, and seems like most regions in Mexico have cleaned up any surplus. Prices will increase headed towards mid-December.



# CV GRAPE TOMATOES

**ALERT!** Grape Tomatoes are extremely tight, and are expected to stay this way on all varieties through December. Snacking Tomatoes in general will be more expensive for the holidays due to low production.





# **CV PEAS**

**Shelled English Peas** will be back in stock by 12/7, with steady supply out of Guatemala.



# CV WATERMELONS

**Watermelons** remain available from Florida and Mexico. Availability is limited overall from both regions, and pricing has increased. Quality has been very nice from Hanshaw Farms out of Florida.



# **CV GRAPES**

New crop import **Red** and **Green Grapes** from Peru are in full swing with prices remaining firm. Quality has shown no flaws, but sizing has indexed to the lower end of each size range on the imports so far.



#### CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

GOOD NEWS! Broccoli Crowns will be promotable for the rest of December, driven by strong volumes on the East Coast, plus robust output from California and Mexico.

In early December, **Cauliflower** is still in excellent supply and high quality. Consequently, in the middle of December, highly competitive pricing continues to be provided. Promotions, however, should be seized quickly since costs are anticipated to increase as the holiday season draws near.



# CV IMPORT STONE FRUIT

Import **Cherries** are in good supply out of Chile, with prices coming down. Quality has been excellent, and sizing is large. We should see prices continue to come down each week, and then see a significant decrease once vessel fruit starts to arrive in January.

The first import **Peaches** are now available from Chile.

Some **Nectarines** are expected to join the mix by mid-December.



# **CV TROPICALS**

**Hass Avocados** continue to be in good supply for early December.

**Mango** supplies are steady. Puerto Rico will begin to have some fruit available in the popular "Pango Mango" label starting around the middle of December on the East Coast.
