## PROMOTABLE ORGANIC EGGPLANT & ZUCCHINI







GOOD NEWS! During the rest of December, Organic Eggplant and Green Squash (Zucchini) will be promotable as growers and shippers are moving a harvest flush of volume from Mexico. This will be a good opportunity for natural foods retailers to highlight both of these warm cooking veg items around the holidays while prices are affordable with good supply. Costs will not get much lower than this. Quality has improved greatly on the Organic Eggplant with new fields.

Organic Yellow Squash, an item known for its big fluctuations in price, quality, and availability will also be more promotable than usual for the remainder of 2024.

#### JANUARY OUTLOOK:

Organic Eggplant, Green Squash, and Yellow Squash, will level out in January as the harvest flush volume cleans up. Expect more normal winter pricing then. Lady Moon Farms will come into season will their Florida post-hurricane replantings in January to open up some East Coast Organic Eggplant and Zucchini supply.



#### OG SPECIALTY CITRUS

The rest of December and January is an excellent time to promote Organic Specialty Citrus and expand your citrus category. In season from California growers now:

"Buck Brand" Organic Citrus available in late December will include:

#### **OG BERRIES**

GOOD NEWS! Organic Blueberries continue to be promotable out of Peru, as supplies are plentiful. Quality has been excellent.

Organic Blackberries will be fairly promotable out of Central Mexico. Growers are starting to hit peak volume, and quality has been excellent. NOTE: Driscoll's brand supplies, however, remain limited as production remains light.

**ALERT! Organic Raspberries** out of Mexico continue to be tight as volume remains limited. Harvests are extremely light, and pricing will remain high. Expect shortages and pro-rates to continue through early December.

**ALERT! Organic Strawberries** will be extremely tight in early December. All regions are struggling to harvest any significant volume. California supplies are winding down, while Mexico and Florida struggle to increase harvests. Expect limited fruit and high pricing.



#### **OG APPLES**

GOOD NEWS! Washington Organic Envy Apples are in excellent promotional supply now through January!

GOOD NEWS! Organic Pink Lady Apples are an excellent apple to promote this season, featuring large fruit with outstanding pink color.

GOOD NEWS! It's time to promote Washington Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples. This is the right fruit at the right price, and with Organic Honeycrisp supplies as tight as they are, this is a great apple to fill the space on the shelf.

NOTE: Organic Honeycrisp Apples will have limited supply and high pricing. It's time to encourage your customers to try other more plentiful varieties.

NOTE: Organic Granny Smith Apples are in very tight supply with strong markets, and the crop is expected to end much earlier than anticipated.

Organic McIntosh Apples are expected to finish for the season near the end of December.

NOTE: Organic Opal Apples are experiencing exterior challenges, with increased stem bowl russeting, larger than normal lenticels, and varying color. These are expected to finish for the season in February, a couple of months earlier than initially expected. Organic SugarBee Apples are also facing more exterior defects this season, but the flesh and eating quality remains excellent.





#### **OG KIWIFRUIT**

**Organic Green Kiwifruit** is transitioning to supplies from California and Italy.

11b clamshells of **Organic Jumbo Kiwifruit** are available from Homegrown Organics in the "Mammoth" brand.

**Organic SunGold Kiwifruit** from Zespri's Italian crop is not in season in an 8/11b clamshell option.



#### **OG HARD SQUASH**

Organic Spaghetti, Delicata, and Kabocha Squashes will make the switch to new crop Mexican product through December. Meanwhile, Organic Acorn and Butternut Squashes remain in abundant supply out of Pennsylvania.

**NOTE: Organic Kabocha Squash** is tight in supply in mid-December due to limited availability as we transition into the new crop from Mexico.



#### OG GRAPES

**ALERT!** Import **Organic Green Grapes** are in limited supply with extremely high pricing.

**Organic Red Grapes** are expected to arrive in late December.



#### **OG PEPPERS**

Following very spotty supplies earlier this month, Organic Red, Yellow, and Orange Bell Pepper volume is improving from greenhouses in the Mediterranean region. Mexico production will ramp up in January, along with more Organic Mini-Sweet Peppers.

ALERT! Organic Green Bell Peppers continue to be very short in supply out of Florida and Mexico. Pricing is very high for December and there have been supply gaps. New plantings in both winter growing regions will ramp back up in January bringing much needed relief this item.



#### OG HASS AVOCADOS

NOTE: Generally, Organic Hass Avocados remain expensive. After last week's price increase from shippers in Mexico on Organic Hass Avocados, things seem to have leveled off.

Continue to promote 60 ct fruit, as it remains more readily available compared to 48 ct **Organic Hass Avocados.** 

**NOTE**: Equal Exchange brand **Fair Trade Organic Avocados** will be light in production with their grower base this winter.



#### **OG SWEET POTATOES**

**GOOD NEWS!** Premium California **Organic Sweet Potatoes** are in promotable supply through mid-December as we approach the Christmas holiday. All varieties are readily available, with pricing locked in through the remainder of the year.



#### **OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER**

**Organic Broccoli** prices are easing down as more volume comes on in Southern California winter growing regions.

NOTE: Organic Cauliflower is expensive and in short supply for mid-December due to slow growth from cool nights in the winter growing regions of CA and AZ. Some relief is coming in late-December with an outlook for slightly better harvest volume.



#### **OG FALL FRUIT**

There should be enough supply of **Organic Cranberries** to meet holiday demand in December.

**Organic Fuyu Persimmons** will be available through mid-December before concluding by the end of the month.

**NOTE: Organic Pomegranates** from California are now done for the season.



#### **OG GREEN BEANS**

Bulk **Organic Green Beans** are back in season for the holidays, with wonderful quality coming out of Mexico on Covilli's Fair Trade product.





#### OG RADDICHIO

**ALERT! Organic Raddichio** is struggling out of California. Expect out-of-stock and light availability until later in January.



#### **OG PEARS**

**NOTE:** The 2024 USA **Organic Bartlett Pear** supply will wind down faster than usual. Supplies are expected to dwindle in January.



#### **OG CELERY**

**ALERT! Organic Celery** prices are spiking up as growers face an impending stretch of low yields with less supply than demand. Expect iffy fill rates and higher prices now through January.



#### **OG CITRUS**

GOOD NEWS! Excellent supply and quality of Organic Mandarins are coming from California. Promote Organic Satsuma and Murcott/Clementines in bags or bulk.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Navel Oranges supply is strengthening, with outstanding quality and flavor. Smaller Organic Navels are especially promotable in mid-December, with occasional spot buys in Jumbo 36/40ct too.

**Organic Cara Cara Oranges** harvest is slow but will ramp up as we get further into December. **Organic Blood Oranges** will ramp up in January.

**Organic Grapefruit** is currently coming from both California and Mexico. Quality from both regions has been outstanding, and pricing is starting to mirror each other.



#### **OG TROPICALS**

**Organic Royal Star Papayas** are in good supply by mid-December from Mexico, with good quality.

**Organic Mangos** from Ecuador are now available and should remain steady. Peru fruit has also begun to arrive. Sizes 10 ct and 12 ct will be available.

**Organic Dragon Fruit** from Mexico will be available in limited supplies, but a gap is expected for late December.

Be sure to check out **Organic Passion Fruit, Feijoa**, and **Kiwano Melons**, available from California in limited supplies during December.



#### OG TOMATOES

Quality is excellent on Quebec greenhouse-grown Organic Cluster, Beefsteak, and Cherry On-thevine Tomatoes and supplies are steady headed into January.

NOTE: Organic Grape, Cherry, and Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes remain on the pricier side with light volumes from Florida and Mexico for December. This segment will improve around New Years with better availability from both regions in January, including the return of Lady Moon Farms Florida product.

**ALERT! Organic Roma Tomatoes** are in very short supply for the remainder of December. Higher prices and some supply gaps are expected.

## Earthbound Farm ORGANIC



#### **OG CUT VEG**

**ALERT!** Earthbound Farms **Organic Cauliflower Florets** and **Rice** packs will be out-of-stock in mid-December and remain in spotty supply for the rest of the month due to low yields and slow-growth in their winter growing regions. Their **Organic Broccoli Floret** fill-rates are improving as the month progresses.

**NOTE:** Earthbound Farms cleaned-snipped **Organic Green Bean** packs have seen major out-of-stocks and supply gaps in December due to poor harvest quality that cannot be packed. Fill-rates are expected to gradually improve in late-December.

#### OTHER STORIES

- Organic Bunch Beets from California are beautiful, and LOCAL bulk 25lb Organic Beets are in great supply.
- Organic Burdock and Celeriac are available for the season and ready to add a healthy boost to your soups.

## **CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS**

DECEMBER 13 - DECEMBER 20, 2024

### **DECEMBER GREENHOUSE TOMATO SPOT BUYS**





GOOD NEWS! Ontario greenhouse growers are finishing their season with a bang with lots of volume and spot-buy deals on **Beefsteak** and **Cluster Tomatoes** for December. **Campari Cocktail Tomatoes** are also quite promotable! Consider using these items as your main volume and value play for the Tomato category headed into the holidays.

Then in January, supplies will shift to primarily new crop Mexico greenhouse **Beefsteak** and **Cluster Tomato** supply. With that shift, prices are expected to move up off the floor to more normal levels.

**Snacking Tomatoes** have been pricier and limited in volume in December due to low production in both Florida and Mexico. New plantings will coming on in those regions at the end of the year and should bring better supply and affordability on **Grape** and **Cherry Tomatoes** in January.

**ALERT!** Field-grown **Vine Ripe Tomatoes**, both 25lb and 2-layer packs, are very expensive and hard to source for December. Re-plantings in Florida following hurricanes and other weather impacts out of Mexico have kept production low. Expect poor fill-rates and expensiveness to continue until mid-January when new fields in both winter growing regions come into season.

**NOTE: Roma Tomatoes** have been elevated in cost and not abundant for December, though not in as bad a shape as the **Vine Ripe** and **Round Tomatoes.** 



#### **CV CITRUS**

GOOD NEWS! California Mandarins are showing top-notch quality with varieties such as Clementines, Murcotts in the "Halos" brand, and Satsumas. Import Mandarins from Chile and Morocco are very promotable at this time at value pricing on 10/3lb and 15/2lb.

GOOD NEWS! California Navel Oranges of all sizes seem to be in better supply now, with prices coming off and creating more promotable opportunities, especially for smaller fruit and bags.

Cara Cara and Blood Orange harvests are slow to get going but will ramp up as we get further into December. Expect spotty fill rates until January when they will be promotable.

Specialty Citrus currently available includes Pummelos, Stem & Leaf Mandarins, Heirloom Navels, FL Tangerines, and FL Autumn Honey Tangerines.



#### **CV BERRIES**

GOOD NEWS! Blueberries continue to be promotable out of Peru. Quality has been good, and supplies remain strong. Chilean fruit is expected to begin arriving in mid-December, and Mexico production will also begin increasing during this time.

**GOOD NEWS!** Driscoll's high-flavor, large-size spec "**Sweetest Batch**" **Blueberries** are in great supply for December!

Raspberries supplies from Driscoll's remain promotable in mid-December out of Central Mexico. Pricing is aggressive, and quality has been exceptional as growers continue to flush. Other growers will have light to steady supplies.

**Blackberries** remain steady out of Mexico. Production is expected to increase gradually, pricing is steady, and quality has been excellent.

NOTE: Strawberries continue to be limited from all regions. Harvests are light across the board, which is typical for this time of year. Mexico's numbers are light but beginning to improve. Florida harvests are also starting to increase, but most growers are still producing pallet volumes. Quality out of Florida has been excellent on the early crops. Pricing remains strong.



#### **CV APPLES**

The Hudson River **New York Apple** display contest is in full swing. With a huge selection of great varieties and promotional pricing, it's time to take your chance at thousands of dollars in prizes. Be sure to enter before the end of December.

GOOD NEWS! Washington Cosmic Crisp and Envy Apples are in excellent promotional supply. This is a great apple to fill the space of other tighter varieties.

**NOTE:** Washington **Honeycrisp Apples** are in extremely limited supply with very strong markets. It's time to shrink your display, move it to the back of the department, and raise prices. The industry needs to slow down sales of Honeycrisp or risk small gaps between pack-outs and/or a large gap between seasons.

Washington **SugarBee Apples** are starting to show more occasional shoulder russeting, lower color, and random skin defects for the remainder of the season. The good news is that the fruit is still eating fantastic! Unlike previous seasons, this trend is affecting the entire crop. Markets should adjust for the lower grade.





#### CV KIWIFRUIT

The **SunGold Kiwifruit** crop from Italy has started with 12/1lb Zespri clamshell option by now available.

**Green Kiwifruit** from Italy and Greece are now arriving, with Zespri's New Zealand season finished. 1lb and 2 lb clamshells as well as a bulk option on the European fruit will be offered.



#### **CV GRAPES**

**ALERT!** Tight supplies persist on both **Red Grapes** and **Green Grapes** during this Import Season. Expect limited supply and elevated prices until we enter January.

The normal value option on **Large-size Grapes** are very light, so most availability will be on higher priced XL and Jumbo fruit for the rest of December.



#### **CV PINEAPPLES**

There will be a limited amount of **HoneyGlow Pineapples** from Del Monte available during late December, plus **Pinkglow Pineapples**.

GOOD NEWS! Pineapple supplies are ample, with a wide range in pricing in the marketplace, including good spot buys.



#### CV STONE FRUIT

In mid-December, shippers expect to transition from Chilean air-shipped Jumbo Cherries to vessel-shipped Jumbo Cherries in boxes. Prices are expected to drop by about 20% when these arrive for the holidays and January! It's time to promote!

Chilean **Peaches** and **Nectarines** are in stock now. There is good supply available, but small gaps between arrivals may occur.



#### **CV FALL FRUIT**

Fresh **Cranberries** should remain in steady supply for the holidays this year.

POM Wonderful **Pomegranates** are steady for December. The program includes whole **Pomegranates** in bins and cartons, as well as 4 oz and 8 oz POM POM **Pomegranates Aril** Cups.

**Black Mission Figs** from Mexico will be available in a 12/8 oz option.



#### **CV MANGOS**

GOOD NEWS! Mangos remain in good supply, with Ecuador just past its peak shipping and now Peru fruit already making its way into the States.

With last year's El Niño shortages behind us, the market is poised for a solid December and January, with fruit peaking in 9, 10, and 12 ct sizing.



#### **CV PEARS**

PA LOCAL Asian Pears have transitioned to brown varieties, which are eating fantastic.

Decent supplies of **Anjou Pears** are already available and will continue through the spring.

Bartlett Pears are expected to run out for the season in early January. Comice, Seckel, and Forelle Pears are expected to finish for the early in January as well.



#### **CV MELONS**

**ALERT!** Supplies are tight on import **Cantaloupes** and **Honeydew Melons**. Expect increased prices and next to no supply on **Honeydew Melons** through December.

**NOTE**: Full-size **Watermelon** supply is very sparse with elevated prices.

Mini Seedless Watermelons in slightly better



#### **CV GREENS & HERBS**

Texas Kales, Collards, Chards, Parsleys, and other bunch veg, and Herbs are looking lovely with our top-quality "Little Bear" brand product from South Texas.





CV DRAGON FRUIT

White flesh **Dragon Fruit** will be in good supply for the rest of December.



#### CV HASS AVOCADOS

Pricing leveled off somewhat on Hass Avocados after early December's price increases across most sizes. Availability is ok. 60ct are move affordable than 48ct. Bags are reasonably priced.



#### CV BEANS

**Green Beans** and **French Beans** are in okay availability for the holidays.



#### **CV LETTUCE**

GOOD NEWS! Iceberg Lettuce prices are falling with better harvest supply coming from winter growing regions in Arizona.

**Green Leaf, Red Leaf, Romaine** and **Romaine Hearts** will also be more reasonably priced for the rest of December.



#### CV BROCCOLI

**Broccoli Crowns** will be in good enough supply from Georgia and the Southwest to fill holiday demand the remainder of December.

#### 11. ORDER & DISPLAY PLANNING TIPS

- Key Christmas produce displays should be in place by December 16th to maximize sales and profits and to keep your labor force as efficient as possible.
- Bring in your tonnage and items on your December 16th 20th deliveries.
- Stay ahead on your "hard goods" like potatoes, onions and dips. Your shrink risk is minimal, but if you are out of product and waiting for deliveries you are going to miss sales and disappoint customers.
- Keep bananas with good yellow color on display these are great in fruit salads! Stay ahead with color.
- · Beginning on the Wednesday prior to Christmas, every day will be busy and you'll want to capture as many sales as you can.

#### 12. SMART LABOR PLANNING

- Develop an off-hour or evening fill schedule for your "hard goods", like nuts, dried fruit, potatoes, and onions, and "longer code date value-added" items, like salad dressings & dips, salsa, guacamole, hummus, and croutons, juices and jarred fruits, fruit mixes, and snacks.
- Daytime labor should be focused on fruit, vegetable, salad displays and engaging your customers.
- Large orders are expected for delivery on 12/21 and 12/23. Plan ahead so you won't be waiting on delivery trucks those days with items that could have been brought in earlier.
