## **PROMOTABLE ORGANIC BROCCOLI**





GOOD NEWS! December brings an abundance of East Coast Organic Broccoli from the southeast with speed to market and lower freight cost for buyers in the Northeast.

California's output in the growing region to the south has begun to increase, ensuring a strong supply volume and competitive prices during the holiday season.

**Organic Broccoli Crowns** are also promotable for the holidays with multiple growing regions in steady harvest.



#### OG LADY MOON VEG

GOOD NEWS! In Punta Gorda, Florida, Lady Moon's Organic Zucchini, Eggplants, and Green Peppers are still in production.

As the holidays draw near, **Organic Green Bell Peppers** and **Eggplant** will be priced aggressively due to their plentiful supply, while **Organic Zucchini** will continue to be available in regular quantities.

GOOD NEWS! Peak season is here for Lady Moon Farms' Organic Greens in Punta Gorda, Florida! There is an abundance of supply and competitive pricing.

**Organic Kale, Collards**, and other **Greens** plus **Organic Cabbage** should be emphasized and promoted during the holidays and into January when it's diet season! Every single item has been of exceptional quality.



#### **OG APPLES**

**GOOD NEWS!** New crop **Cosmic Crisp Apples** are now plentiful, with market prices expected to ease over the next couple of weeks.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Envy Apples are in excellent supply, setting the stage for a January display contest.

Large premium **Organic Gala Apples** are firming this week as we transition from regular storage to controlled atmosphere storage. Expect a slight market strengthening as we move into the new year.

New crop **Braeburn Apples** from British Columbia will join the organic mix during Christmas week, offering a great variety.

**NOTE:** Washington **Organic Opal Apples** are peaking on very small and blemished fruit. We are prioritizing large premium fruit, but sporadic out-of-stocks may occur during the season.



#### **OG BERRIES**

**Organic Blueberries** remain available from Peru, with nice quality and steady supplies. Light new crop Chilean arrivals are expected via air in the coming weeks.

**NOTE:** Organic Blackberries remain available from Mexico, but lingering El Nino weather has presented quality and pest challenges, causing tight availability. Expect higher pricing and limited supplies in the coming weeks.

NOTE: Organic Strawberries continue to experience strong pricing and limited availability ahead of the holidays. Mexico and Florida are seeing very light supplies, and Baja also has limited availability.

ALERT! Organic Raspberries will continue to be extremely limited from Mexico, with weather patterns and pests affecting harvests. Expect higher pricing and limited availability.



#### **OG BEANS**

**Organic Green Beans** in bulk 25 lb boxes are arriving from Florida and primarily in the 15 lb row pack box from Covilli Fair Trade from Mexico. Expect steady volume into and through Christmas, with outstanding quality.

 ${\bf Organic \ French \ Beans}$  in 10/11b bags are inhouse, with Christmas volume booked and ap-



#### **OG PEAS**

**Organic Snap Peas** and **Organic Snow Peas** are finally available in a 10 lb box starting from 12/21 and beyond, after weather challenges delayed maturity.



#### **OG ASPARAGUS**

ALERT! Organic Asparagus is in tight supply, with very little volume from Mexico. We are supplementing with supplies from Ecuador to cover customer needs. Market pressure is anticipated to continue until the end of January.

Prices have jumped up sharply with this sudden decline in harvest volume.



#### **OG CAULIFLOWER**

Prices increased in early December due to a scarcity of **Organic Cauliflower** from the winter farming regions of Yuma and El Centro during the transition. As the holidays approach and more supply from these growing regions becomes available, price will begin to decline.

Expectations for the holidays should involve moderate costs and steady availability. Nonetheless, there might be opportunities for promotions after the holidays.



#### **OG PEPPERS**

**ALERT! Organic Colored Bell Peppers** are extremely limited, with Canada finishing its crop. Very little supplies are coming from Mexico. Israel growers have some product but flights are impacted by war, causing delays.

Tight supply and high prices are anticipated until mid-January.



#### **OG CELERY**

**NOTE:** December sees a rise in the cost of Californian **Organic Celery** as supply becomes scarce for some shippers. While the quality remains unchanged, promotional opportunities should not be expected.

As January gets underway after the holidays, the market will start to correct itself and return to normal heading towards February.



**OG SPECIALTY FRUIT** 

Limited supplies of Organic Kiwano Melons, Organic Passion Fruit, and Organic Feijoa from California are expected to be available through the holidays.

**Organic Yuca Root** will be limited from Florida at the end of December.



**OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS** 

Due to a lack of overall market availability in December, **Organic Brussels Sprouts** production costs have remained high, even though supplies are becoming more easily accessible from California.



#### **OG ONIONS**

The active conventional market is starting to exert upward price pressure on the **Organic Onions**. Higher pricing is anticipated in January, particularly for **Organic White Onions**.

#### **OG TOMATOES**

ALERT! Organic Snacking Tomatoes, especially Organic Grape Tomatoes are extremely tight on all varieties through December. Expect limited availability and high prices.

**ALERT! Organic Roma Tomatoes** are extremely tight, with prices rising rapidly. The pricing is expected to stay high until the middle or end of January.



**OG GRAPES** 

**Organic Grapes** from Peru are showing nice quality, albeit at higher market prices with California finished.

The "Autumn Crisp" (**Green Grape**) and "Allisons" (**Red Grape**) varieties are robust, but supply is limited.



#### **OG AVOCADOS**

GOOD NEWS! Organic Hass Avocado supplies are ample, providing an opportunity for end-ofyear promotions and a strong start to 2024.



#### **OG CITRUS**

GOOD NEWS! The supply of Organic Mandarins, including Clementines and Satsumas, has improved, making it a great time for promotion. The main Organic Clementine at Four Seasons will be 2 lb Organic "Cuties".

GOOD NEWS! Organic Navels show strong quality, with larger fruit being more promotable. Prices are dropping unevenly for all sizes, presenting an opportune time for promotion. Organic Cara Cara Oranges arrive 12/20.

California's **Organic Lemons** continue to demonstrate high quality, with markets slowly decreasing.



#### **OG LETTUCE**

GOOD NEWS! Organic Leaf and Romaine Lettuces are in plentiful supply, produced from both the East and West Coasts!

**Organic Red Leaf** started off a little slowly, but as of mid-December, volumes begin to rise quickly.

**Organic Leaf and Romaine Lettuce** will be produced in substantial quantities by Lady Moon Farms in Florida. Look forward to a productive rest of the month filled with promotional opportunities as the new year approaches!

Californian production has moved south to the winter growing areas of Yuma and El Centro, and the output and quality are excellent!

These southern West Coast regions provide steady supplies of **Organic Romaine Hearts** and **Iceberg Lettuce**. Pricing and volume should stay consistent throughout December.

Steady supplies of **Organic Pineapples** are expected for the holidays.

**Organic Pomegranates** from California are winding down, with limited quantities available for Christmas. Smaller sizing will be more prevalent as the 2023 season concludes.

#### **OTHER STORIES**

**Organic Papaya** from Mexico will remain steady, with good overall fruit quality, making it a suitable choice for holiday promotions.

The season for **Organic Fuyu** and **Hachiya Persimmons** is finishing up, with limited quantities available for the end of December.

Ask your rep about the brands and programs we offer on organic and conventional.

Take a good look at your inventory on Glacé/Candied Fruit and holiday shipper displays around December 12th-15th to make sure that you have it all out on the sales floor. Consider reducing the retail so you don't carry it over past the holiday. Turn your cash over and start out fresh next year.

#### 2. PARTY TRAYS & GIFT BASKETS

These are a **MUST** during the holidays for those hosting parties or going to gatherings! Veg and fruit trays sell very well during December. Plan out your orders with your Four Seasons rep.

Many independent retailers find success in packing their own custom fruit and gift baskets in store. Gone are the days of Red Delicious Apples, Globe Grapes, and Florida Navel Oranges navels. Include modern varieties like premium California Navel Oranges and Washington Fuji, Granny Smith, and Honeycrisp Apples. Premade fruit baskets may be available by pre-order from Four Seasons as well. Merchandise gift boxes of Ooranges and Mandarins too.











#### **3. EASY-PEEL MANDARINS**

Easy-peel Mandarins, for snacking and giving, continue to be- come more popular around the holidays. Offer Clementine and Satsuma Mandarins in 2 or 3lb bags. Keep a few gift boxes around. Loose or tote bag displays of Stem & Leaf Mandarins can really make a statement!

#### **11. ORDER & DISPLAY PLANNING TIPS**

- Key Christmas produce displays should be in place by December 16th to maximize sales and profits and to keep your labor force as efficient as possible.
- Bring in your tonnage and items on your December 15th-19th deliveries.
- Stay ahead on your "hard goods" like potatoes, onions and dips. Your shrink risk is minimal, but if you are out of product and waiting for deliveries you are going to miss sales and disappoint customers.
- Keep bananas with good yellow color on display these are great in fruit salads! Stay ahead with color.
- Beginning on the Wednesday prior to Christmas, every day will be busy and you'll want to capture as many sales as you can.

#### **12. SMART LABOR PLANNING**

• Develop an off-hour or evening fill schedule for your "hard goods", like nuts, dried fruit, potatoes, and onions, and "longer code date value-added" items, like salad dressings & dips, salsa, guacamole, hummus, and croutons, juices and jarred fruits, fruit mixes, and snacks.

• Daytime labor should be focused on fruit, vegetable, salad displays and engaging your customers.

• Large orders are expected for delivery on 12/22 and 12/23. Plan ahead so you won't be waiting on delivery trucks those days with items that could have been brought in earlier.

**Four Seasons**

## **SPECIALTY CITRUS SEASON BEGINS**



**GOOD NEWS!** More **Specialty Citrus** is finally coming into season from California for the late December holiday sales, and to kick off January Diet Season.

**Stem and Leaf Satsumas** in bulk and 3 lb clamshells are in peak season flavor and availability for the rest of December.

"Vintage Sweet" Heirloom Navel Oranges in high graphic 3 lb bags arrive to the East Coast on 12/15. These Sweet Oranges from old-line orchards are a great seller.

Pink flesh **Cara Cara Oranges** are now in season from California in bulk and bag options! **Blood Oranges** are running late this season and will start closer to January.

The now famous Dekopons brand as **Sumo Citrus** are expected to arrive around New Years. Large sizing is anticipated, with 25 sz being the smallest for 18 lb bulk cartons.

**Meyer Lemons** and "Wonderful" brand **Seedless Lemons** are now in peak season.



#### **CV BERRIES**

**NOTE: Strawberry** supplies out of Florida tightened quickly, with pricing bouncing back. Rain and a major storm expected in the state are keeping fruit tight. Limited production from California and Mexico is expected, with supplies remaining tight.

NOTE: Blackberries continue to be tight overall out of Mexico, with El Nino weather presenting growing challenges, including rain, humidity, and cooler than normal temperatures. Expect pricing to be higher with limited availability as we transition into 2024.

**Blueberry** supplies will tighten as Peru's season slows down. Arrivals are still on the water, with light Chilean supplies. Expect delays in the Ports during the holidays, leading to potential shortages. Mexico is delayed, with production not expected until the new year. Pricing should hold or increase depending on supply.

**NOTE: Raspberries** are also experiencing weather challenges, with poor conditions affecting quality and leading to limited availability. Pricing remains strong or higher.



#### **CV CITRUS**

**GOOD NEWS!** Halos "Clementine" **Mandarins** from California exhibit exceptional quality, and peak availability. Imported **Mandarins** face tight availability due to delays in Morocco with 5 lb Gift Boxes finally arriving 12/22.

GOOD NEWS! California Navel Orange pricing is dropping as more shippers and growers are entering the market with strong fruit. It's a great time to push/promote with Oranges! Ask about opportunities on Jumbo Navels in cartons and display bins.

**Grapefruit** from Texas continues to catch up to demand, while Florida is in good supply.

**Lemon** pricing is slowly decreasing as supply strengthens, with outstanding quality from California.

**Limes** remain promotable for the short term, but Mexican markets are expected to strengthen. Deals on small fruit from Columbia are still available.



#### **CV APPLES & PEARS**

The Washington **Hunnyz Apple**, with its Honeycrisp parentage and sweet taste, is back for mid-December, offering an **Apple** for snacking desserts and baking for the holidays.

New crop **Cosmic Crisp** and **Envy Apples** are flowing freely, providing a great selection for the holidays.

GOOD NEWS! Eastern (PA and NY) and Washington Apples are plentiful, with a wide variety available for eating, snacking, baking, and cooking.

**NOTE:** Washington **LucyRose Apples** will finish for the season by the end of December.

**GOOD NEWS! Pears** are abundant during National Pear Month, with all the great varieties available for sampling to drive holiday sales.



#### **CV NATURESWEET TOMATOES**

ALERT! NatureSweet's Tomato line, especially the medley varietals for the Constellation pack, are facing supply challenges for December.

**Twilights** and **Comets** are also experiencing shortages due to slower maturation caused by colder temperatures in growing regions.

This trend is expected to persist into the middle of January. Heavy prorates and occasional out of stocks are likely according to NatureSweet.



#### **CV ARTICHOKES**

GOOD NEWS! Californian Jumbo Artichokes maintain their excellent supply and quality trend. Anticipate these circumstances to endure with competitive pricing throughout the holiday season. To increase sales, broaden your product offerings and run promotions.



#### **CV TOMATOES**

ALERT! Snacking Tomatoes are very tight on all varieties through December, primarily on Grape Tomatoes. Expect limited availability and high prices.

ALERT! Roma Tomatoes are very tight, with prices rising rapidly. This pricing is expected to stay high until the middle or end of January.

**NOTE: Round/Vine Ripe Tomatoes** are limited, with Mexico fields in transition and Florida experiencing heavy rain. Sub-par quality and delays are causing a gap in availability, with significant price increases for premium fruit. Expect this pricing to change in the middle to end of January.



#### **CV AVOCADOS**

**GOOD NEWS! Hass Avocado** supplies from Mexico are ample as we finish 2023, with great deals for the end of the year. Steady supply is expected for 48 and 60ct fruit, as well as 32ct sizing, in both pre-conditioned and hard green fruit options for December.



#### **CV GRAPES**

**Green Grapes** will remain promotable through December, with stronger supply on the East Coast.

**Red Grapes** for December will remain firm due to heavy demand, with limited fruit available.

Drought in the Panama Canal is causing about 25% of slot reductions as boats need to lighten up to navigate the shallows, potentially impacting **Grape** arrivals in the near future.



#### **CV ONIONS**

**NOTE:** The **Onion** market has surged in the past few weeks, particularly for **White Onions**. Adverse weather conditions in Mexico have led to higher demand for domestic **Onions**, causing growers to face a short supply situation. This trend is expected to continue across all packs and sizes into January.



#### **CV KIWI**

**SunGold Kiwi** from Zespri's Italian program is available for the rest of December.

**Green Kiwi** continues to be in great supply from Greece, Italy, and California, available in volume-filled and several clamshell options.



#### **CV PINEAPPLE**

**PinkGlow Pineapples** from Del Monte will be available in mid-December.

**Pineapple** supplies are beginning to tighten slightly as the holidays approach, with pricing expected to rise a bit through the end of the year.



#### **CV CAULIFLOWER**

The supply of **Cauliflower** from the West Coast's southern growing regions remains steady, but as the holidays draw near, prices began to increase. The quality has been excellent, and for the remainder of the year, availability will be consistent.



**CV STONE FRUIT** 

**Red Cherries** from Chile are in steady supply, with nice quality and size. The transition from air shipments to vessel fruit around the first week of January is expected to ease pricing, but supplies could become slightly firm during the transition.

Chilean **Peaches** are in good supply and are expected to be joined by **Apricots**, **Nectarines**, and **Plums** as we move into early to mid-January.



#### **CV MANGOS**

**NOTE: Mango** pricing has spiked as expected, with Brazil finishing up on the East Coast. Ecuador will be the primary source for **Mangos** through the end of the year.

Peru will also have some fruit for the beginning of 2024, with **Ataulfo Mangos** from Ecuador expected in very limited volumes.



#### **CV ASPARAGUS**

ALERT! Asparagus will remain extremely tight, with increasing prices into Christmas. The transition from Peru to Mexico is underway, but extreme heat in Peru is affecting volume, and there are flight cancellations or delays. The perfect storm of conditions is expected to persist until mid to end of January.



#### **CV LETTUCES**

**GOOD NEWS!** After moving southward to winter growing regions on the West Coast, December brings exceptional availability, affordability, and quality for the **Lettuce** category. For the rest of the year, highlight every kind of **Lettuce**!

In December, **Romaine Hearts** and **Iceberg Hearts** are both widely accessible, with Iceberg costs continuing to be competitive!

Leaf Lettuce is consistently available and has a competitive price. While a little less readily available and a few dollars more expensive, Romaine Lettuce is nonetheless easily accessible.

**Black Mission Fig** supplies dipped unexpectedly due to weather events in Mexico, resulting in slightly more sporadic supply and slightly higher pricing.

**Italian Chestnuts** are in season and in good supply, with bulk and 20/1 lb mesh bag options available.
