

OG NAVELS & MANDARINS

GOOD NEWS! It is a great time to promote Organic Mandarin Oranges from California., There is excellent supply, great flavor, and strong quality headed into January.

Organic Cuties brand 15/2 lb Organic Mandarins will be on promo for a January display contest at Four Seasons this January. Organic Halos brand will also be available, plus there will be occasional spot buy deals on 2 lb Organic Mandarins from California on other shipper brands.

Organic Navel Orange demand has supply on large fruit playing catch-up once again. Smaller fruit and bagged fruit is promotable at this time, while large fruit (like 56 ct) remains tight from most shippers.



OG LADY MOON FLORIDA VEG

GOOD NEWS! Organic Romaine and Leaf Lettuces from Florida, grown by Lady Moon Farms, are thriving in late December. Outstanding quality, steady supply, and promotional opportunities will be available through January!

For late December Organic Grape, Cherry, and Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes from Lady Moon Farms in Florida are starting to produce fruit after delays by having to replant after hurricanes. Production will continue to improve for January.

Lady Moon Farms will start Florida Organic Green Cabbage during end of December, with Organic Red Cabbage arriving later in January.

Lady Moon Farms has started with Florida Organic Jalapeños, Shishito Bags, Green Peppers, and will begin Organic Eggplant at the end of December. Quality has been excellent and will continue to improve.

East Coast Organic Bok Choy, Baby Bok Choy, Fennel, Collards, Kales, and Parsleys from Lady Moon Farms in Florida are showing excellent quality.



OG BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Blueberries remain promotable, featuring Driscoll's Peruvian fruit with excellent pricing and quality. Promote with confidence.

Organic Blackberries are promotable from Mexico, with nice quality and aggressive pricing on shipper brands. NOTE: Driscoll's Organic Blackberries are priced higher.

ALERT! Organic Strawberries remain very limited as well, with demand exceeding supply nationwide. California production has ended, while Florida and Mexico production remain light. Expect high pricing and limits through the New Year.

ALERT! Organic Raspberries will be very limited through the start of the New Year due to flat harvests and increased demand. Expect possible pro-rates and high pricing.



OG AVOCADOS

Organic Hass Avocado supplies are ramping up, with prices on 48s easing slightly. Prices are still elevated but supply should be sufficient headed into January.

NOTE: Equal Exchange Fair Trade **Organic Hass Avocados** will be very limited in 48 ct and 60 ct sizes at the start of December, with a complete gap by the end of the month.



OG GRAPES

Import **Organic Grape** supply is in good shape, though markets are high. **Organic Red Seedless** (Sweet Celebrations) and **Green Seedless** (Sweet Globes) from Peru are available.



CA/AZ OG LETTUCE

GOOD NEWS! Organic Iceberg Lettuce and Romaine Hearts from California are in excellent condition, with increasing production. Pricing is expected to improve as we approach the New Year.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

ALERT! Organic Brussels Sprouts will gap in late December and early January. Increased volume from Mexico is expected to start in early to mid-January. During this period, expect limited to no availability until new crop begins.



OG CUCUMBERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Euro Seedless Cucumbers are becoming increasingly promotable in late December, making them an excellent item to highlight for the remainder of the month. Strong volume and quality are expected to continue into January.

Organic Mini Cucumbers are steadily available but slightly elevated in cost, with strong quality.

Organic Cucumbers from field production in Mexico are fairly steady though not promotable.





OG CAULIFLOWER

ALERT! Organic Cauliflower volume remains restricted with high pricing; however, production improvements are anticipated in late December and early January. As volume improves, pricing is expected to steadily decline.

ALERT! Earthbound Organic Cauliflower Florets and Riced Cauliflower are experiencing heavy pro-rates and out-of-stock in December due to lack of input product or poor quality. Fill-rates will improve during January.



OG COLOR BELL PEPPERS

NOTE: Organic Color Bell Peppers from Israel are starting to yield consistent production with high quality in December. Although prices are slightly elevated with the supply chain refilling, the product quality remains excellent.

Increased Mexican production in January will help ease costs and improve availability on retail packs.



OG CELERY

ALERT! Organic Celery remains limited in December, with high costs reflecting availability challenges.

ALERT! The situation is likely to worsen before improving in early January as production picks up. Expect subpar quality during this time and expensive price points on **Organic Celery** and **Celery Hearts**.



OG KIWI

Organic Green Kiwi from Italy is available in volume-filled options. Homegrown Organics' Organic Mammoth Kiwi 20/1 lb clamshells will offer an Organic Green Kiwi option from California.

Organic Sungold Kiwi from Zespri's Italian crop is now available for end-of-December sales in an 8/1 lb clamshell option.



OG PEARS

Organic Red Anjou Pears remain in good supply.

Organic Anjou and **Organic Bosc Pears** are in firm supply with elevated pricing.

NOTE: Organic Bartlett Pears are wrapping up early January before a gap until imports arrive in February.



OG CHARD GREENS

NOTE: California **Organic Chards** are expected to stabilize after a rocky market in much of December and are now harvesting better headed into January.



OG COCONUT CHUNKS

Four Seasons is now offering **Organic Vanil- Ia-Flavored Fresh Coconut Chunks** from Genuine Coconuts, a popular item that complements post-holiday eating habits. Promote these for the New Year!

This item is a line extension to add to the already strong-selling original **Organic Fresh Coconut Chunks** line from Genuine Coconut.



OG APPLES

The **Organic Envy Apple** Promo and Display Contest is ready to boost sales in January. Build large displays for increased sales with this on -trend, delicious apple, and for a chance to win prizes.

Organic Apples are in excellent supply to close out 2024. Stock varieties like Ambrosia, Cosmic Crisp, Fuji, Gala, Kanzi, Lady Alice, Opal, Pink Lady, Rockit, SugarBee, and Sweetango.

ALERT! Organic Granny Smith and Honeycrisp Apples remain extremely limited with strong, rising pricing.



OG BROCCOLI

GOOD NEWS! Organic Broccoli is expected to improve in late December following a challenging transition from Salinas Valley to Southern California and Yuma, AZ. Anticipate better pricing and strong quality to close the year, with promotional opportunities available in early January!

GOOD NEWS! Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli and Broccoli Rabe are experiencing strong volume and favorable pricing. Great quality and promotional volumes should continue into the New Year.



OG GREENHOUSE TOMATOES

Organic Beefsteak and **Cluster Tomatoes** are consistent in late December, with solid production and excellent quality expected into early January.

Organic Heirloom Tomatoes remain limited.

OTHER STORIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Mangos from Peru are available, though 12 ct are very limited. Focus on the more plentiful and promotable 9 ct and 10 ct sizes.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Royal Star Papayas are in good supply through December. Quality has been strong.

Organic Fuyu Persimmons are available through the end of December, with potential carryover into early January. Check out **Organic Passion Fruit** (limited), **Kiwano Melons**, and **Feijoa**, now available in limited supplies from California.

NOTE: There are industry wide short supplies on Organic Thyme and Sage in mid-to-late December causing issues with fill-rates on retail packs and poultry blend packs for the holidays.

NOTE: Organic Asparagus for late December is on the expensive side with erratic volumes causing hiccups in the supply pipeline.

Organic Green Beans are now in season from Mexico with nice volumes on good quality arriving from Covilli brand Fair Trade.



CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

SUMO CITRUS BEGINS!

GOOD NEWS! SUMO Citrus is back in season from California!



SUMO Citrus are known as **Dekopons** in Japan, a cross of mandarin and orange varietals known for its sweetness, deep flavor, large size, and easiness to peel since the flesh separates from rind without difficulty. **SUMO Citrus** is challenging to grow so pricing is higher than regular oranges, but citrus lovers have become very loyal to this reliably delicious and convenience fruit.

The 2024-2025 crop is looking good. Available at Four Seasons Produce for late December and early January will be 18lb trays of 25ct and high-graphic 12/2lb bags of **SUMO Citrus**. Peak season promotions and a display contest are planned for February with the season lasting into April.

Speaking of Specialty Citrus...

Vintage Sweet Heirloom Navel Oranges are back into season from California with 10/3lb high graphic bags. These Navel Oranges are from old-line orchards and tree stock, often the original varietals like "Washington" that were first planted in California over 100 years ago, and allowed to tree-ripen for excellent sugar levels. Vintage Sweet Heirloom Navel Oranges will be on promo with a display contest for Four Seasons Produce customers in January.

Pink-flesh, low-acid **Cara Cara** and red-flesh **Blood Oranges** are beginning peak season in California. The supply pipeline is filling up on bulk 56/72ct **Cara Caras** full boxes and 88/113sz 44ct half boxes in late December, plus 12/3lb **Cara Cara** bags and 18/2lb **Blood Orange** bags. Peak season will be January through March.

Florida **Autumn Honey Tangerines** are in peak season from Florida and will be followed later in January by Noble's highly prized **Juicy Crunch Tangerine**. California **Stem & Leaf Satsuma Mandarins** will continue to be at their best through New Year's in 22lb bulk and 6/3lb clamshells.



CV TOMATOES

Grape Tomato volume from Florida has increased in Late December. Expect improved volume and lower costs for New Year's Eve.

Roma Tomato production remains steady from Florida and Mexico in Mid-to-Late December.

NOTE: Round Tomatoes are becoming steady in late December, but costs will remain elevated. Florida product has begun after a delayed start in December due to impacts from hurricane season, and Mexican product will begin in early to mid-January.

NOTE: Beefsteak and Cluster Tomato prices are rising for late December. Limited production is driving quick increases in markets after promotable volumes were available throughout the past month. Expect these conditions to worsen as the month continues and January begins.

Campari Tomatoes remain in steady volume, though costs have begun to increase as December continues. Expect this trend to continue into the New Year.



CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

GOOD NEWS! Broccoli Crowns and Bunches from Georgia remains readily available at a reasonable price. Mexican and West Coast production continue to offer excellent secondary options. Continue to promote Broccoli to drive additional sales in early January.

Sweet Baby Broccoli and **Broccoli Rabe** are now back to experiencing steady volume. High quality and improved volume should continue into the New Year.

ALERT! Cauliflower supply remains limited in late December with high prices; however, some improvements have been made. Expect costs to remain elevated until supply volume increases.

Cauliflower can be a volatile commodity, so shifts in production improvements may occur if favorable growing conditions prevail.



CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Raspberries will continue to be promotable from Driscoll's. Pricing is aggressive, and quality is outstanding. Continue to promote with confidence.

GOOD NEWS! Blackberries will continue to be promotable out of Mexico. Harvests have increased, and quality has been very nice. Pricing will be aggressive through the end of the month on pints and 18 oz.

GOOD NEWS! Blueberries remain promotable!
Peruvian fruit remains available with good quality.
New crop Chilean fruit is starting to arrive, and
Mexico fruit is also beginning to increase. Mexico
fruit will command a premium price, but all prices
will be promotable. Quality has been excellent.

NOTE: Strawberry supplies out of Florida are tight overall. Pricing will remain high. Quality has been excellent. Mexico continues to harvest light volumes as well. California production will stay primarily on the West Coast.



CV KIWI

Green Kiwi from Italy and Greece are now in season. 1lb and 2lb clamshells, as well as a bulk option on the European fruit, are stocked.

Zespri's Italian **SunGold Kiwi** has started. Supplies will be steady, and we will offer an 8/1lb clamshell option.



CV COLOR SWEET PEPPERS

NOTE: Greenhouse 11 lb Color Bell Peppers remain limited in late December, creating elevated costs. Though costs remain high, they have stopped increasing and are staying relatively consistent. These conditions are expected to hold true until Mid-January, when Mexican production is expected to increase, driving improved costs.

15 lb Fancy XL **Red Sweet Peppers** from Mexico field production are back in stock with nice quality.



CV LETTUCE

GOOD NEWS! Lettuce is promotable once again! The transition to southern Winter growing regions has resulted in outstanding production. Iceberg and Romaine Hearts are increasingly promotable in December as increased production has driven advantageous costs.

Leaf and **Romaine Lettuce** costs have followed, with increased volume creating promotional opportunities. Highlight the **Lettuce** category as the New Year approaches!



CV CELERY

NOTE: Celery supply has slowed as December has progressed, and with less production, prices have increased. Quality remains strong, but supply volume will remain restricted, and costs elevated into January.

ALERT! Additionally, **Celery Hearts** remain very limited.



CV ONIONS

NOTE: White Onions have jumped up in price through December with more limited availability.

Red, Yellow, and all bagged **Onions** remain steady through December, and are expected to continue that way at least into the New Year.



CV GRAPES

NOTE: Import Grape prices are exceedingly high as all colors remain limited.

Supply is expected to ramp up in the middle of January, bringing the market back to normalcy.



CV MELONS

Mini-Seedless Watermelon production is improving, making this the more promotable of the melon category.

ALERT! Import **Honeydew** are very limited in volume with expensive pricing due to short supplies. 5ct are tight, 6ct are virtually non-existent headed into the new year.

NOTE: Import **Cantaloupe** are pricy with light supplies arriving to the US for late December and early January.



CV MANGOS

GOOD NEWS! Mangos remain in good supply, with Ecuador and Peru continuing to be the main players. All sizes will be available.

NOTE: The Ataulfo Mango volume will be essentially nonexistent. With a smaller Peru crop and suspect quality, growers are opting not to ship from Peru. There is a chance we will be out of the variety until Mexico starts sometime in Late January.



CV CUCUMBERS

Greenhouse Euro and Mini Cucumbers have seen slight price increases, though volume and quality remain strong. While the overall market is trending upward, deals are still available to help drive additional volume. Continue to promote to drive further sales.

Field-grown super select **Cucumbers** are in better supply from Mexico with some volume from Florida too.



CV CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! California Navel Oranges have excellent quality and supply. This is a great time to push for flavor and price. There will be good buys popping up on 3 lb bags as well as jumbo 36/40 ct from time to time.

GOOD NEWS! There is exceptional quality from California on "Halos" Mandarin Oranges with nice supply. Import Mandarins from Chile and Morocco is very promotable at this time when compared to California markets.



CV APPLES

GOOD NEWS! It's time to promote Envy Apples with high-graph POS and bins, as well as promotional markets. There will be a big January Envy promo and display contest to support the selling.

Most Western Apples are in excellent supply for the end of the year, including Cosmic Crisp, Envy, Fuji, Gala, Gold Delicious, Granny Smith, Hunnyz, Lucy Rose, Pazazz, Red Delicious, Rockit, SugarBee, and Sweetango.

NOTE: Honeycrisp Apples are tight this year with prices rising.

Most eastern Apples (NY, PA) are in excellent supply for the end of the year, including Ambrosia, Cortland, Crimson Crisp, Empire, Evercrisp, Fuji, Gala, Gold Delicious, Granny Smith, Lady, McIntosh, Pink Lady, Red Delicious, Rome, Ruby Frost, Snap Dragon, and Stayman.



Driscoll's high-flavor "**Sweetest Batch**" line offers retailers the opportunity to offer some of the best tasting **Berries** along side Driscoll's regular premium berries.

Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Blueberries** 8/11oz are showing nice size and great texture to go with flavor our of Mexico and Peru. Rich-tasting Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Strawberries** are just beginning in Florida in 8/14oz packs. Extra tasty Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Blackberries** will return in early January with 12/10oz packs.

Shipper-brand 12/9.8oz **Jumbo Blueberries** continue in season from Peru.



CV PEAS

NOTE: Container arrival difficulties in Miami have made **Snow** and **Snap Peas** difficult to source from Guatemala via Florida. These container issues are also impacting **French Beans** and **Shelled English Peas**.



CV ARTICHOKES

Larger-sized 12 ct and 18 ct **Artichokes** are becoming increasingly available in late December. Stronger production has brought improved pricing as the month continues. Enlarge displays and begin to promote for early January!



CV STONE FRUIT

GOOD NEWS! Import Cherries are promotable, with aggressive pricing, and further drops are expected as we move into January, when the fruit supply peaks.

Import Apricots from Chile have arrived in limited supply, along with good supplies of **Peaches**, and **Nectarines**.



CV HERBS

Bunch Parsley and Cilantro have been more difficult to source in New Jersey due to declining temperatures, raising prices. However, the new Texas crop looks strong!



CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

NOTE: Brussels Sprout volume remains limited in December. As supply tightens, price increases have ensued. Expect these conditions to persist throughout the remainder of December and into early January.



CV PINEAPPLE

Some **HoneyGlow** and **PinkGlow Pineapples** are available for Christmas and New Year's!

Pineapple supplies are tightening quickly, especially on 6ct sizing. Expect pricing to escalate leading up to January.


Is "Diet Season" still a thing?

For the past decade or so, the first few calendar weeks in January after New Year's Day have become known in the retail and produce business as "Diet Season." After holiday celebrating with food, sweets, and drink, perhaps too much in November and December, many chose a weightloss goal, special diet, or exercise regimen as part of a New Year's Resolution. In recent decades, this has translated to a boost in consumption of fruits and vegetables in early to mid-January at stores known for fresh produce and organics, driven even further by at the at-home juicing and smoothie making trend. All of this led to sharply increased demand in produce departments, followed by a drop-off as many people gave up on their strict diets, weight-loss goals, and resolutions by the time January ended.

The past three Januaries have shown a plateauing, if not slight decline, of this demand spike for resolution diets. Why? Perhaps this: The consumer mindset, influenced by social media and culture, seems to be shifting away from resolution diets based on societal expectations, guilt from overindulgence, and comparison. Those diets and goals are often unrealistic or unsustainable. Instead, there is a noticeable shift towards wellness, self-grace, positive behaviors, mindful eating, clean eating, functional foods, and sustainable changes to start the New Year.

January is still a chance for a fresh start, though retailers may consider replacing Diet in their merchandising and marketing efforts with terms like "New Year, New You."

Promotion focus can center on **wellness** (foods that impact your mood), **function** (foods that help you with something), and **better for you or free-from** (foods like organic, clean ingredient). The good news is that fresh fruits and vegetables and other produce department items are still the star of January.

New Year, New You sentiments will impact shopper demand at your produce department and grab-and-go drink sets.

Be ready with Functional Beverages and Fresh Beverages:
