ORGANIC TOMATO OUTLOOK





Canadian and Mexican greenhouse **Organic Cluster** and **Beefsteak Tomatoes** will once again be consistently available for purchase starting in February. Costs remain slightly elevated, but pricing is expected to ease in early February with the potential for promotions.

GOOD NEWS!

Organic Roma Tomatoes are coming on in improved volumes allowing for more promotable pricing.

Fair Trade **Organic Heirloom Tomatoes** from Mexico are coming into peak season with steady availability.





Support USA family and women-owned farming!

Lady Moon Farms' Florida grown **Organic Snacking Tomatoes** are starting to yield better harvests following disruptions from fall hurricanes and January cold weather. Lady Moon **Organic Grape, Cherry, Orange Cherry,** and **Rainbow Cherry Tomato** 12/1pt clamshells are improving in availability for February.



OG AVOCADOS

NOTE: Organic Hass Avocado supplies have rebounded and availability should be better at the start of February. However, pricing has not declined as quickly as it previously increased. Costs are expected to remain slightly elevated as the Big Game approaches.

Four Seasons will be offering free Avocados from Mexico point of sale display bins with purchases for display builds. Ask your rep for details.

NOTE: Equal Exchange Organic Hass Avocados will remain limited for the duration of the 2025 Mexican season. 48 ct and 60 ct Organic Fair Trade Hass Avocados will be available in smaller amounts along with an 8/4 ct ReadyCycle Tray option.



OG LADY MOON FL VEG

GOOD NEWS! Lady Moon Farms' Organic Kale from their Florida farm is of exceptional quality, and looks outstanding on display this winter.

Premium, Florida Lady Moon **Organic Lacinato** & **Red Kale**, **Collards**, **Fennel**, **Bok Choy**, **Baby Bok Choy**, and **Green & Red Cabbage** are in season.

GOOD NEWS! There are still plenty of Lady Moon Farms **Organic Romaine Hearts** available and promotional opportunities are favorable.

Florida's **Organic Romaine**, **Red** and **Green Leaf** and **Lettuce** yields remain strong as February begins. In early to mid-February, there should not be any disruptions to cost or supply consistency.



OG BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Blackberries remain promotable out of Mexico with steady supplies and pricing on shipper labels. Higher priced Driscoll's Organic Blackberries are showing excellent quality and good flavor with steady volume.

Organic Blueberries will remain available from Chile and Mexico. Supplies from Mexico are lighter, with the majority of volume coming from Chile. Quality has been excellent.

Organic Strawberry harvest production is increasing out of Baja, MX. Pricing has eased significantly ahead of Valentine's Day and supplies are in good shape. Quality on new fruit has been outstanding.

NOTE: Organic Raspberries remain limited and priced higher than usual. These conditions are expected to persist through most of February. However, quality has been excellent for available fruit.



OG ASPARAGUS

Organic Asparagus production in Mexico is ramping up quickly. Lower pricing is anticipated by mid-February along with excellent quality.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

GOOD NEWS! Mexico's production of Organic Brussels Sprouts remains in peak condition during late January. As February gets underway, promotional pricing remains available and advertisements are encouraged. Mesh bag packs are available as a grab and go option.



OG CUCUMBERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cucumbers from Mexico continue to show good availability, and pricing remains favorable. This Organic Cucumbers pricing will start February with a great opportunity for promotions.



OG GRAPES

Organic Grapes have a consistent supply though high pricing from Peru and South Africa.

The organic market will not become promotable in the same way as the conventional market since there are no **Organic Grape** imports from Chile.



OG PINEAPPLES

NOTE: Organic Pineapple supplies have tightened to start February. 6 ct, 7 ct, and 8 ct sizes will be available but in limited volumes. Expect slight price increases.



OG CELERY

For February, **Organic Celery** conditions are improving. Costs continue to decline as more volume becomes available. By mid-February, expect stable prices, consistent availability, and high quality.



OG COLOR BELL PEPPERS

As February approaches, Mexico's production of **Organic Color Bell Peppers** continues to increase. Higher volumes will result in more affordable pricing.

Israeli production remains consistent, providing a steady supply of high quality fruit.

Promotional opportunities for **Organic Peppers** are encouraged in February.



OG CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Mandarin Oranges have mostly transitioned to the Organic Tango variety. Known for its outstanding flavor and quality. Organic Cuties and Halo brands will be steady. Organic Poppies brand Organic Mandarins will be promotable.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Navel Oranges have strong quality and good supply out of California. Prices continue to decline gradually across all sizes.



OG SPECIALTY CITRUS

Organic Cara Cara Oranges are in peak season with spot buys on Jumbo sizing.

Organic Blood Oranges are showing deep burgundy flesh color at this point in the season. 1/2 carton bulk are readily available and new 18/2lb bags will arrive by 2/5.

Organic Heirloom Navel Oranges and Kumquats are in season.

Ask your rep about Buck brand **Organic Specialty Citrus** availability which changes weekly.



OG SOFT SQUASH

ALERT! Organic Green Squash continues to face challenges with both availability and high prices. Organic Green Squash remains in short supply to start February.

ALERT! Organic Yellow Squash is also facing limitations, and quality issues have been observed when available. High prices for Organic Squash will linger until the weather warms in Mexico and Florida growing regions.



OG APPLES

The **Organic SugarBee Apple** promo and contest is currently underway for February. This is a great opportunity to sample and showcase this excellent apple.

Washington **Organic Fuji**, **Gala**, **Granny Smith**, and **Honeycrisp Apples** are becoming more limited with prices on the rise. This trend is expected to continue for the remainder of the season. Most noticeably on **Organic Honeycrisp**.

To make up for the inability to promote **Organic Honeycrisp** this season, retailers are encouraged to promote **Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples**, which are affordable. **Organic Envy Apples** are another good option.

Organic Royal Star Papayas are in good supply from Mexico as February begins. The quality has been strong.

ALERT! Organic Green Bean production in Mexico has been affected by cooler temperatures. This may lead to temporary supply gaps as harvesting remains limited.



OG GREEN BELL PEPPERS

Florida **Organic Green Bell Peppers** faced a small gap heading into February with some supply issues. However, Lady Moon Farms is back up and running at full capacity.

In the meantime, Mexican product has been sourced, leading to a blended market. We anticipate being back in full supply with Lady Moon Farms **Organic Green Bell Peppers** as February continues.



OG MANGOS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Mangos will be promotable as the Organic Peruvian season winds down. Larger fruit like 7 ct will become more prevalent, allowing for excellent promotions on premium sizes.

First of the Mexico season **Organic Ataulfo Mangoes** are now available with more fruit arriving in the first week of February. Currently, smaller 20 ct fruit is being offered. A limited supply of premium twelve count fruit will become available soon. Pricing at the start of the 2025 season remains elevated.



OG KIWI

Homegrown Organics' **Organic Mammoth Kiwi** Clamshells remain a great option from California and will be available at the start of February.

NOTE: Organic Sungold Kiwi supplies from Zespri's Italian crop are becoming limited and are expected to decline by early February.



OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

GOOD NEWS! There are a plentiful amount of Organic Cauliflower and Organic Broccoli being harvested in the West Coast desert areas. These two items continue to make excellent promotional choices with their outstanding quality and affordable prices.

Promote these leading up to the Big Game as they are great candidates for vegetable platters. Prices will start to change in mid-February due to colder temperatures in these growing regions. Seize any sales opportunities before prices start to shift.

OTHER STORIES

Organic Eggplant supply is becoming limited, and quality issues have been noted. Pricing for **Organic Eggplant** is beginning to rise due to these factors. Improved quality is expected in early February.

NOTE: Organic Spaghetti Squash is expected to be limited through early February as supply transitions between Mexican growing regions.

NOTE: Organic Delicata Squash supplies are tightening with multiple shippers expected to experience gaps through April. One shipper is anticipating limited supply during this period, but availability will be sporadic.

New Year, New Packaging!



We heard you loud and clear, and we agree. Part of our commitment to sustainability needs to include our packaging, so we're making some updates.

In January 2025, Mother Earth Organic Mushroom products will be switching over to compostable and sustainable fiber tills made of bamboo and bagasse (sugar cane waste materials).

What does this mean for me?

PRICING CHANGES. There are new costs associated with the updated packaging and Mother Earth Organic Mushroom products will have a minimal price increase in January 2025.

PRODUCT LINEUP CHANGES. The 10 oz. and 12 oz. organic white mushroom packages will be discontinued (This includes the 10x10 oz. Silver Dollar and 10x12 oz. White). The ten-pack of organic Sliced Shiitake will be eliminated (Options will include 12 or 6 packs of 5 oz. only).





Why we're doing this.

165,726 POUNDS ANNUALLY. That's how much plastic we're eliminating by switching to our new bamboo tills. Let's put that into perspective – 165,726 pounds is equivalent to:

GOOD NEWS!

Grape prices are dropping. There are price differences in variety and region, but overall this market has dropped, creating value and excellent promotions for this category on all **Grape** colors. Promote aggressively now through February, especially on large sized **Reds** and **Greens** from Chile. XL and Jumbos will be at a higher money than the Large.

Specialty Grape varieties and packs are coming into peak supply from the South American import season. These items will be stocked at Four Seasons Produce in February and allow for enhancements to retailer grape sets:

In addition to bulk loose **Idaho Russet Potatoes**, a full line of Green Giant **Red, Gold, and Russet Potatoes** are in stock from Idaho. Plus, Spuddy Buddy brand **Idaho Russet** value bags are available.

CV APPLES

GOOD NEWS! Washington Cosmic Crisp Apples remain the most promotable Apple. Continue to feature this item.

NOTE: Eastern and Western **Honeycrisp Apples** continue to tighten in supply and markets continue to rise.

Eastern **Ruby Frost Apple** demand has increased over the last month and supplies are more limited and peaking on larger fruit.

If you want to try a delicious yellow apple out of Washington be sure to give the **Opal Apple** a shot and sample them to your customers.



CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Blueberry supplies will be promotable as Chilean fruit becomes more abundant. Central Mexico fruit continues to be available at a premium, offering outstanding quality and taste on the Driscoll's brand.

Blackberry production is set to improve as weather conditions stabilize. Rains and cold temperatures had previously halted production, but conditions are now improving, and supplies should begin to increase and become steady again. While the quality has generally been good, some pockets of issues due to rain damage are expected.

Strawberries will continue to be available from both Mexico and Florida. Both regions were affected by rain, which slowed production, but weather conditions have since improved. Quality has been excellent from both regions.

NOTE: Raspberry production will remain tight through early to mid-February, as crops begin to gap. Expect high pricing and limited availability during this period. Quality has been very good overall, despite the supply limitations.



CV ARTICHOKES

GOOD NEWS! During their prime Coachella, CA season, Jumbo Artichokes continue to yield exceptional quantities. Expect outstanding quality and lower prices in February. Create eye-catching displays to boost sales of your products.



CV CELERY

GOOD NEWS! California continues to supply a consistent amount of Celery in February. The quality continues to be favorable, and the price is fair.



CV AVOCADOS

Hass Avocado supplies are improving from Mexico, and prices are moving downward a bit from the highs of January. 60 ct and 70 ct will show the best price point value and availability for the Big Game.

All sizing and bagged options will be available for large displays along with some point of sale material supplied to us by Avocados From Mexico and Calavo Growers.



CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

GOOD NEWS! California Brussels Sprouts will be consistently available throughout February. Throughout the month, you can count on outstanding quality and affordable prices.



CV POMEGRANATES

The last of the season California POM POM Wonderful Arils will be available before a smooth transition to imported Arils around the middle of February. Four Seasons will carry the Sun Belle Pomegranate Aril Cups when the import season begins.

Import Pomegranates from Israel are very nice, and availability provided a smooth transition from the California crop. 6 ct single layer cases on the imported fruit are in stock.



CV CAULIFLOWER

GOOD NEWS! Cauliflower heads into February with good volumes and promotability.

Cooler temps in growing regions in the Southeast and Southwest may push pricing back up later in February.



Red Kiwi will be available in an 8/1 lb clamshell for the first part of February before finishing their season. The Red Passion Kiwi has some tinges of red flesh and is a nice addition to the Kiwi category.

Green Kiwi from Europe will be available in fair to good supplies for the start of February. Sungold Kiwi from Zespri's Italian crop is expected to last into February.



CV MANGOS

Import Kent Mangos will be promotable into the beginning of February.

OUTLOOK: Mexico is expected to start soon and should have some limited Ataulfo Mangos and a few Tommy Atkins Mango varieties as well. The Mexican season will start slowly with limited availability to start February, but volume should increase by March.



CV CUCUMBERS

GOOD NEWS! Volumes of Euro Seedless Cucumbers are still in peak season from Mexico. There is plenty of Canadian production available at the same time. Extend displays to encourage more movement and boost sales with these lower prices.



CV BROCCOLI

GOOD NEWS! Broccoli Crowns are still primarily being sourced on the East Coast, especially in Florida. Regular pricing combined with outstanding quality has created a great opportunity to highlight in ads. In addition, production still comes from Mexico and the desert growing areas of the West Coast. Overall, each of the three areas provides favorable accessibility and quality.



CV TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! The production of **Roma** and **Vine Ripe Round Tomatoes** in Mexico is robust. Early
February continues to see aggressive pricing and
great quality. The availability is further increased
by additional Florida production. As the Big Game
draws near, showcase these **Tomatoes** in salsa
making displays.

GOOD NEWS! Early February continues to see an abundant supply of Medley, Cherry, and Grape Tomatoes. These will be fantastic additions to Big Game party vegetable platters.

Late January saw the start of an improvement in greenhouse Cluster and Beefsteak Tomato prices, which is expected to continue into February. The quality remains exceptional, and volumes are growing.

LOCAL PA Asian Pears are expected to finish for the season in early February and then gap for a period of months until the first imports arrive.

Bartlett Pears are expected to transition from Washington to new crop Imports over the next few months.

ALERT! In Georgia, cold temperatures are impacting **Green Bean** harvest, though picking continues there could be potential gaps expected until temperatures rise in mid-February.



CV LETTUCE

GOOD NEWS! The **Lettuce** category is still continuing with significant supply through the start of February.

Despite some cooler temperatures, the desert growing areas of the West Coast are producing **Lettuce** very well. The West Coast has an exceptional supply of **Iceberg** and **Romaine Hearts** with promo pricing, while the East has more to offer. **Leaf** and **Romaine Lettuce** yields continue to generate competitive prices and superior products.



CV PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! 15 lb Elongated Sweet Red Peppers are still very affordable and readily available.

GOOD NEWS! Favorable conditions for Color Bell Peppers are still present in February.

Due to the high volume of supply for all three colors, which are currently produced in Mexico, prices are decreasing. In February, keep an eye out for deals and promotions.



CV CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! California Navel and Heirloom Navel Oranges have a strong supply and excellent quality. This is a great time to promote for flavor and price.

Mandarins are in good shape.

Specialty Citrus is a great way to zest up your citrus displays. The following varieties are available. SUMOs, Minneola Tangelos, Stem and Leaf Mandarins, Blood Oranges, Cara Caras, and Pummelos.



CV STONE FRUIT

GOOD NEWS! Nectarines are delivering excellent quality with promotional supply and aggressive markets. Now is the time to promote these for the next few months.

Black Amber Plums have just arrived, and the first **Lemon Plums** of the season are expected next month from Chile.

Imported **Cherries** from Chile are in excellent supply right now but supplies will decrease over across February and cause prices to rise.

OTHER STORIES

Michigan and LOCAL storage crop Root Vegetables are in excellent supply.

Melon supply is getting stronger. However, prices are still very high due to supply catching up to demand.

GOOD NEWS! Cucumbers from Mexico are currently showing better availability and pricing. Growers continues to be very aggressive with pricing on this veg though.

NOTE: Eggplant supply is becoming limited, and there are some quality issues. Pricing is starting to rise due to these challenges. Expect quality to see improvements in February.

Asparagus supplies from Peru remain strong, while production in Mexico has slowed slightly due to cooler weather. The next peak season for Mexico will begin in mid to late February.
